The Court may exercise its discretion to **disregard** a late filed paper in law and motion matters. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1300(d).)

Unlawful Detainer Cases – Pursuant to the restrictions in Code of Civil Procedure section 1161.2, no tentative rulings are posted for unlawful detainer cases and appearances are required.

Court Reporting Services – The Court does not provide official court reporters in proceedings for which such services are not legally mandated. These proceedings include civil law and motion hearings. If counsel want their civil law and motion hearing reported, they must arrange for a private court reporter to be present. FOURTH ACCOUNT CURRENT AND REPORT OF CONSERVATOR, AND PETITION REQUESTING APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTING

TENTATIVE RULING: Conservators of the estate have repeatedly failed to obtain a bond, pursuant to Probate Code section 2320, and have indicated that they no longer wish to be conservators. Pursuant to Probate Code section 2650, subdivisions (c) and (j), and section 2654, Conservators shall be removed and their powers are hereby suspended. The Napa County Public Conservator will be appointed successor conservator, pursuant to Probate Code section 2680. Conservators are compelled to surrender the estate to the Napa County Public Conservator. The hearing for removal of the Conservators and appointment of the Napa County Public Conservator is set for August 17, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. F. The clerk is to give notice.

THIRTEENTH ACCOUNT AND REPORT OF CONSERVATOR; PETITION FOR ALLOWANCE OF FEES TO CONSERVATOR OF ESTATE AND PERSON AND ATTORNEY FOR CONSERVATOR

TENTATIVE RULING:

Based on the report of the court investigator, the Court determines by clear and convincing evidence that conservatee cannot communicate, with or without reasonable accommodation, a desire to participate in the voting process, and therefore orders conservatee disqualified from voting pursuant to Elections Code section 2208

GRANT petition, including fees as prayed. After a review of the matter, the Court finds the conservator is acting in the best interest of the conservatee. Thus, the matter is set for a biennial review hearing and an accounting in two years, on July 25, 2019, at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. F. All accounting documents must be filed at least 30 days prior to the hearing. The court investigator shall prepare a biennial investigator report for the next hearing date. The clerk is directed to send notice to the parties.

REVIEW HEARING

TENTATIVE RULING: The matter is continued to September 6, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. C to allow for the filing of the court investigator's report. In addition, before the next hearing date, the co-conservators shall file: (1) Notice of Conservatee's Rights (Judicial Council form GC-341); and (2) Determination of Conservatee's Appropriate Level of Care (GC-355). The clerk is directed to send notice to the parties.
