

TENTATIVE RULINGS

FOR: August 2, 2017

The Court may exercise its discretion to **disregard** a late filed paper in law and motion matters. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1300(d).)

Unlawful Detainer Cases – Pursuant to the restrictions in Code of Civil Procedure section 1161.2, no tentative rulings are posted for unlawful detainer cases and appearances are required.

Court Reporting Services – The Court does not provide official court reporters in proceedings for which such services are not legally mandated. These proceedings include civil law and motion hearings. If counsel want their civil law and motion hearing reported, they must arrange for a private court reporter to be present. Attorneys or parties must confer with each other to avoid having more than one court reporter present for the same hearing.

APPEARANCE REQUIRED. There is no Proof of service on relatives within 2nd degree. (Prob. Code §§ 1821(b), 1822.) Petitioner should also be prepared to show what assets are part of the trust, and what assets will remain in the conservatorship estate. If assets will remain in the conservatorship estate, a bond will be required. (Prob. Code § 2320.)
