The Court may exercise its discretion to **disregard** a late filed paper in law and motion matters. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 3.1300(d).)

Unlawful Detainer Cases – Pursuant to the restrictions in Code of Civil Procedure section 1161.2, no tentative rulings are posted for unlawful detainer cases and appearances are required.

Court Reporting Services – The Court does not provide official court reporters in proceedings for which such services are not legally mandated. Parties are responsible for either making the appropriate request in advance or arranging for their own private court reporter. REVIEW HEARING

TENTATIVE RULING: The Court waives the requirement to file Notice of Conservatee's Rights (Judicial Council form GC-341) and Determination of Conservatee's Appropriate Level of Care (Judicial Council form GC-355) due to the age of this case. After a review of the matter, the Court finds the conservator is acting in the best interest of the conservatee. Thus, the case is set for a biennial review hearing in two years, on October 5, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. in Dept. B. The court investigator shall prepare a biennial investigator report for the next hearing date. The clerk is directed to send notice to the parties.
